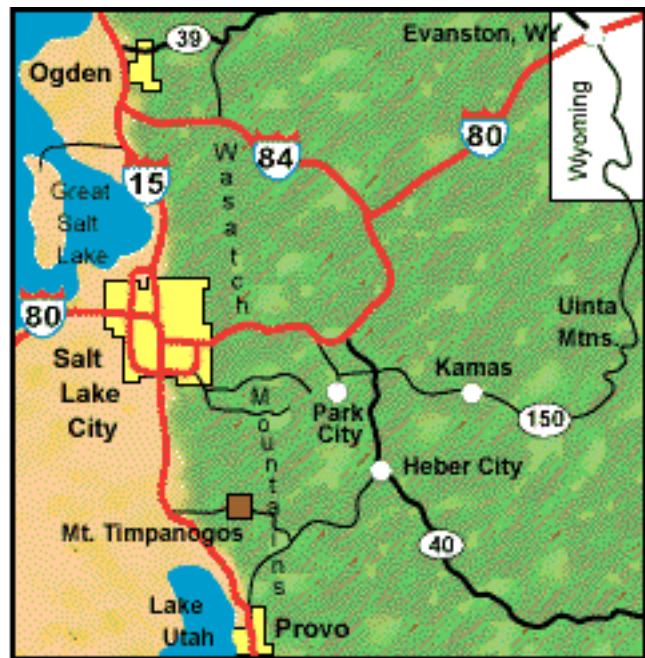


Park City is an attractive resort town in the Wasatch Mountains, 32 miles east of Salt Lake City. Once a mining town, Park City now caters to the thousands of skiers who come to its three excellent ski resorts -- Park City Ski Area, Deer Valley Resort and The Canyons. Park City has accommodations for more than 12,000 visitors, nearly 100 restaurants and tons of shops in a fairly compact downtown area.

In summer, Park City slows down, but remains a popular destination. It serves as a base for exploring the many hiking and mountain biking opportunities in the surrounding mountains.

Winter Recreation

Skiing / Boarding - Resorts

Park City has three large ski resorts -- Park City Ski Area, Deer Valley Resort and The Canyons. Together they boast 280 runs with 40 lifts and gondolas capable of handling 60,000+ skiers per hour. Located just 32 miles from downtown Salt Lake City (mostly by interstate), Park City is the most popular skiing destination in Utah.

Ski Jumping & Bobsled/Luge

Utah Winter Ski Park near Park City is the sight of the 2002 Olympic Bobsled, Luge and Ski Jumping competitions. Before the rest of the world comes though, you can tackle 18 or 38 meter ski jumps and a 4,000 foot long combined bobsled/luge run. Lessons and equipment rentals are provided. The ski park is located off Hwy 224 about 4 miles north of Park City. P.O. Box 980337, Park City, Utah 84098; 435-658-4200.

Cross-Country Skiing

There are good opportunities for groomed and ungroomed cross-country skiing near Park City.

- White Pine Touring Center is a cross-country ski resort in Park City. It has 12 miles of groomed trails covering a variety of terrain and offer rentals and instruction. [Box 68, Park City, UT 84068; 801-649-8710.](#)
- Homestead Cross-Country Ski Center is located at the Homestead Country Inn near Heber City, about 18 miles south of Park City. It also has 12 miles of groomed trails covering a variety of terrain and offer rentals and instruction. [Box 99, Midway, UT 84049; 800-327-7220.](#)
- Wasatch Mountain State Park on the eastern edge of the Wasatch range has many miles of [ungroomed] trails through the woods. It is located about 18 miles south of Park City. Contact Wasatch Mountain State Park at 435-654-1791 for more information.
- The Uinta Mountains begin about 20 miles east of Park City. Hwy. 150 into the range is plowed at the lower elevations providing access to many miles of ungroomed, wooded trails. See [Uintas-Winter Recreation](#) for details.

Snowmobiling

There are hundreds of miles of designated snowmobile trails and routes in the Wasatch Mountains south of Park City and in the Uinta Mountains 20 miles west of Park City. There are also open riding areas in the region.

Getting There

Park City Mountain Resort is located in the town of Park City on the eastern side of the Wasatch Mountains. It is 32 miles from downtown Salt Lake City; 37 miles from the airport. Nearby is Deer Valley Resort and The Canyons Resort. Simply take I-80 30 miles to the Park City exit (Hwy 224) and take it south 6 miles to Park City. The season at Park City usually runs from mid-November to mid-April. It is open daily from 9:00 to 4:00 every day. Night skiing is available from Christmas through March, 4:00 to 9:00, on a few runs.

From the airport, take I-80 30 miles to the Park City exit (Hwy 224) and take it 9 miles south through Park City. See Skiing Transportation for information on shuttles and the like.

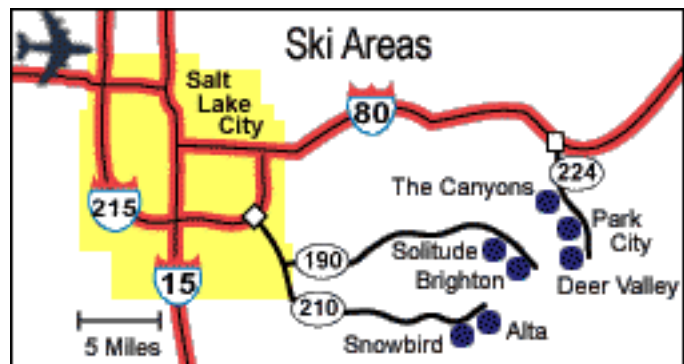
The Canyons

Park City has become a very popular mountain biking destination. Each of the three ski areas -- Park City, Deer Valley and The Canyons -- offer miles of good mountain biking routes down their wooded slopes. There are also a variety of rides in the mountains near town.



TRAIL DESCRIPTIONS

Riding Areas

The Ski Resorts

Deer Valley is Utah's most upscale ski area. It is also a noted mountain bike destination in summer. It has a 45-mile network of trails, a good percentage of which are single track. Routes are available for beginners to advanced. The resort provides rentals and instructional clinic.

Park City Mountain Resort has nearly 20 miles of designated trails of both single- and double- track.

The Canyons is also promoting mountain biking on miles of trails.

Lifts operate at each resort for those who don't want to fight with gravity.

Telemark Park on the outskirts of Park City is a double cloverleaf that combines three trails. Snow Park Loop is a combined single/double track route with some pleasant views. McKinley Gap Loop has gentle climbs and gradual descents through switchbacked turns above Deer Valley Condos. Spin Cycle Loop is a great single track route with a very technical descent through a twisting aspen-lined hollow.

Located on the edge of town, this short loop provides some nice views and technical challenges as it winds through heavy aspen groves. The trailhead is located at the southern end of Lowell Avenue (where it starts to turn sharply to Empire Ave.).

This route follows mostly dirt roads with some single track through nice forested areas and past some old mining areas. Start along Daly Avenue on the north side of town.

This route starts with the Lower Daly route described above, but then breaks away at about Mile 3 at Petticoat Junction Trail. The trail continues to Deer Valley and Telemark Park before returning via paved roads to your starting point. The route offers some good forested single track and some excellent panoramic views of the area.

The Tour Des Suds is the name of a popular annual mountain bike race run since 1983 in the fall. The route basically runs from Daly Ave. on the north side of town up to Guardsman Road. It passes through wonderful aspen and pine forests and features some excellent single track. The trail can be difficult to follow, so you'll want a good map or instructions before setting out.

This route travels along forest service dirt roads through pretty alpine meadows and past some excellent views of the surrounding rounded peaks of the Uinta Mountains. The route starts about 15 east of Kamas off Hwy 150.

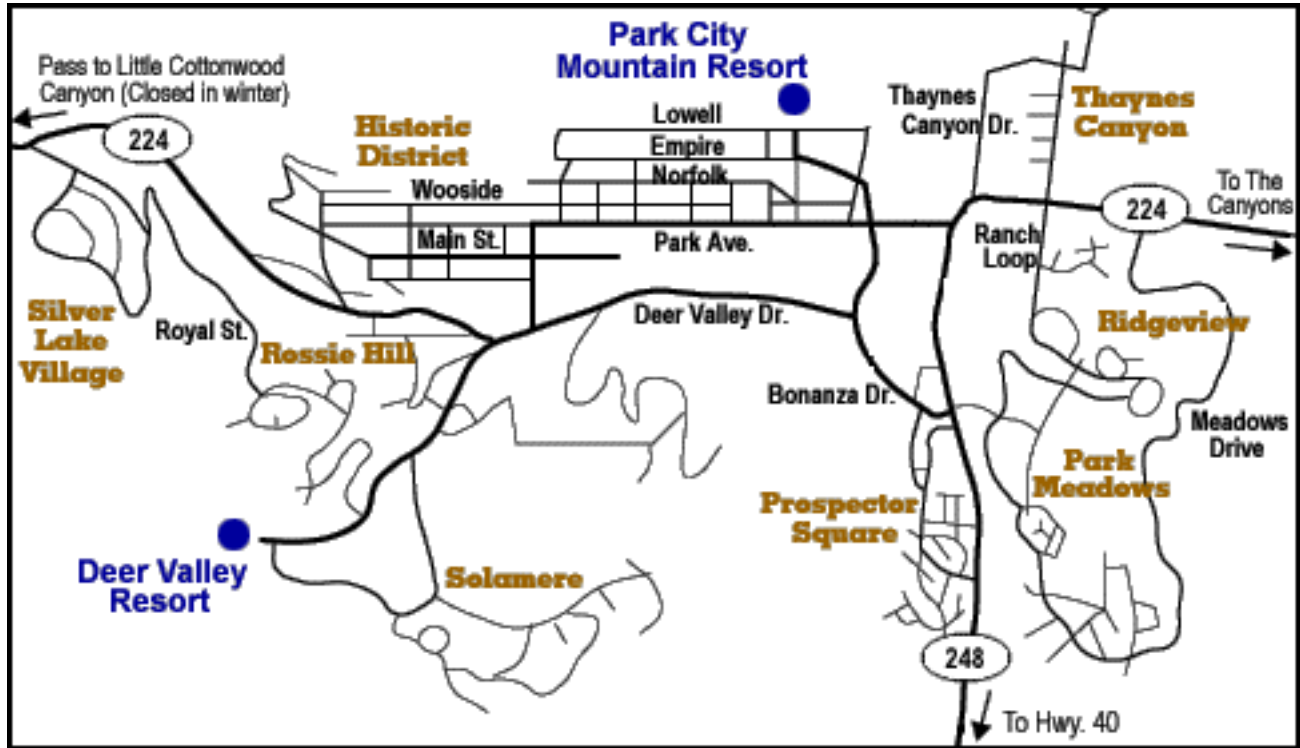

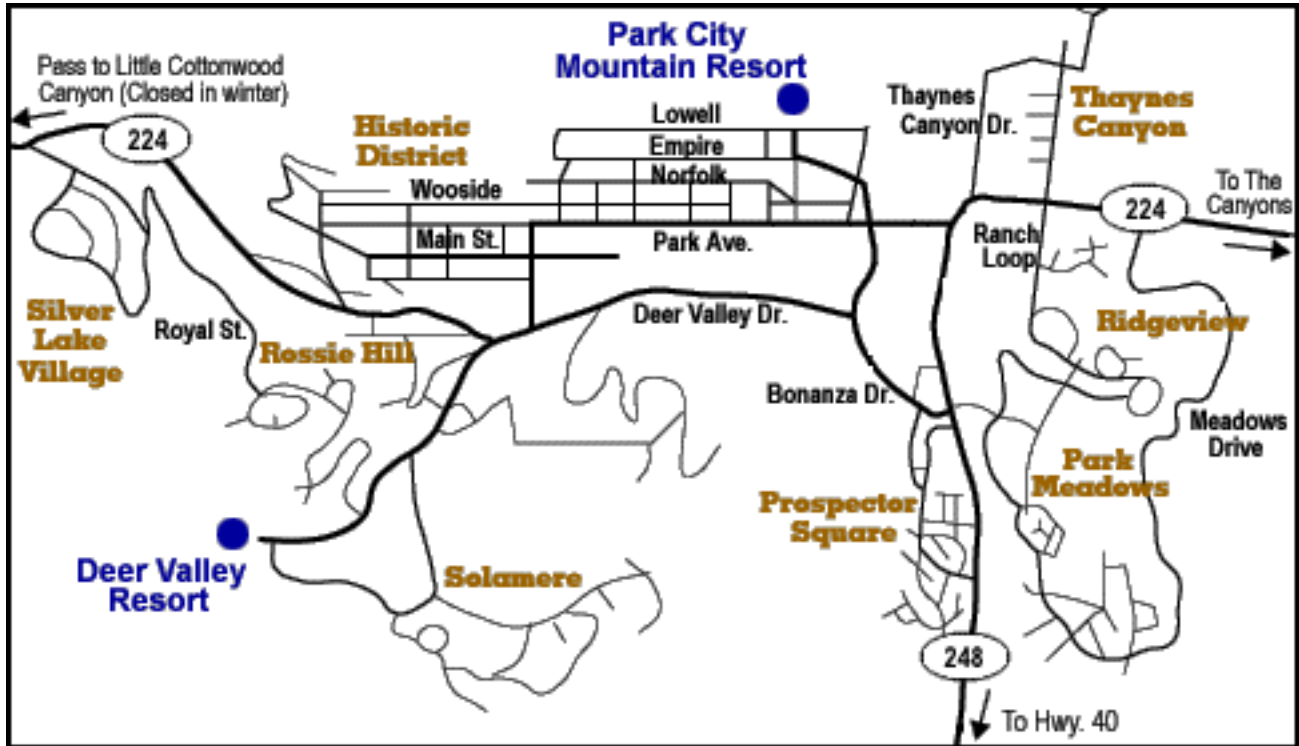

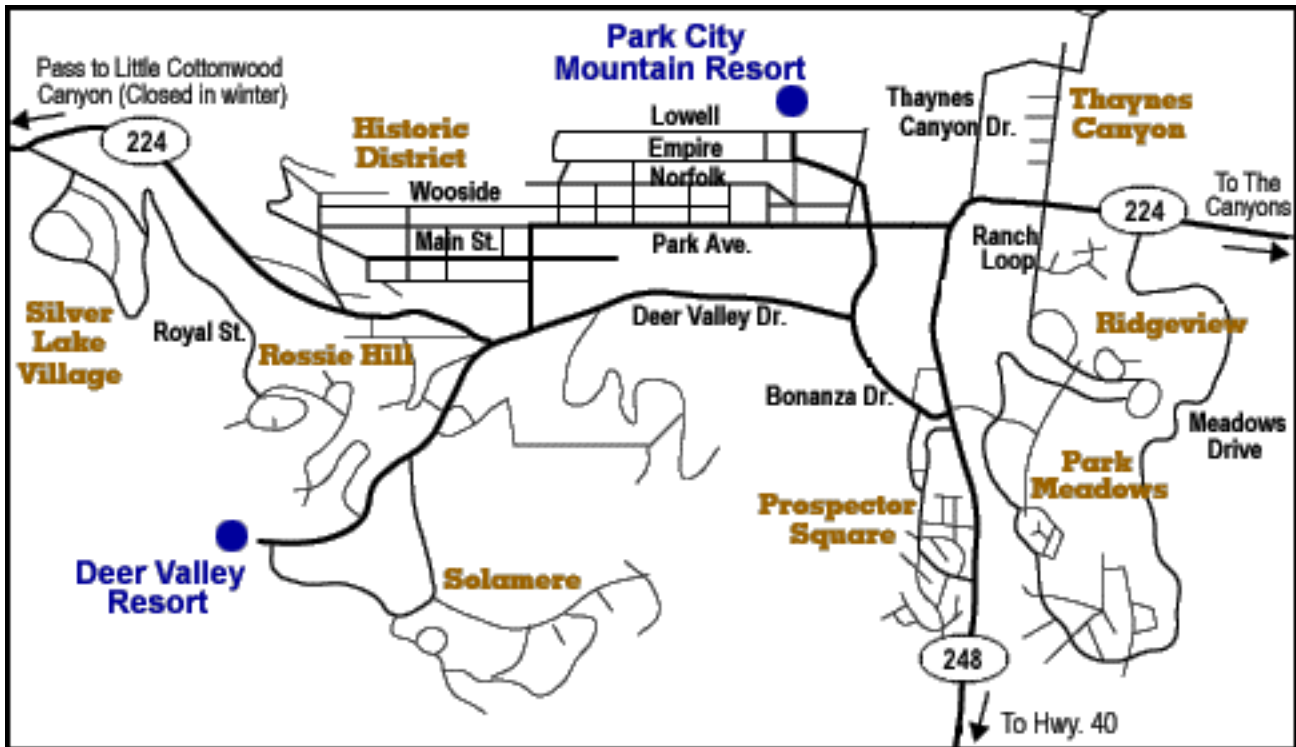

PUBLIC CAMPGROUNDS

There are a few National Forest Service campgrounds in Big Cottonwood Canyon, west of Park City.

- Redman is an attractive campground nestled peacefully among the pines 13 miles up canyon. 37 sites; drinking water; vault toilets; elev. 8,300'; late-June to mid-Oct.; \$12. It has 5 group sites.
- Spruces is very attractively situated along a tumbling mountain stream beneath heavy pines. It is 9 miles up canyon. 86 sites; drinking water; flush toilets; elev. 7,400'; June to mid-Oct.; reservations: 800-280-2267; \$14. There are 20 group sites.

There are also a few state Park campgrounds in the area.

- Wasatch Mountain State Park (435-654-1791) is located on the eastern side of the Wasatch Range, 10 miles south of Park City. The park has a 27 hole golf course and good hiking and horseback riding opportunities. It has 4 campgrounds with 138 total sites (Cottonwood I and II, Oak Hollow and Mahogany) and 1 group campground (Little Deer Creek). Each has drinking water, modern restrooms with showers, and RV hookups. Sites can be reserved by calling 800-322-3770. Fees are \$14-16.

The single family campgrounds are located at 6,000' and are opened April to Oct. Little Deer Creek is at 7,600' and is opened from late-May to late-September.

- East Canyon State Park Campground is located along the 680-acre East Canyon Reservoir, a popular fishing and boating destination for Salt Lakers. It is located about 25 miles north of Park City off Pioneer Memorial Scenic Byway (Hwy 65). 31 sites; drinking water; modern restrooms with showers; RV hookups; elev: 5,700'; April to mid-Oct.; reservations: 800-322-3770; \$11.

There are also dozens of National Forest Service campgrounds in the Uinta Mountains along Hwy 150, 15-30 miles east of Park City. See Uintas-Camping for information on those.

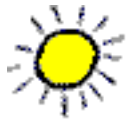

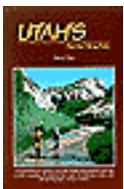

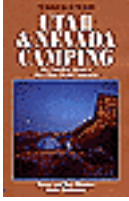
